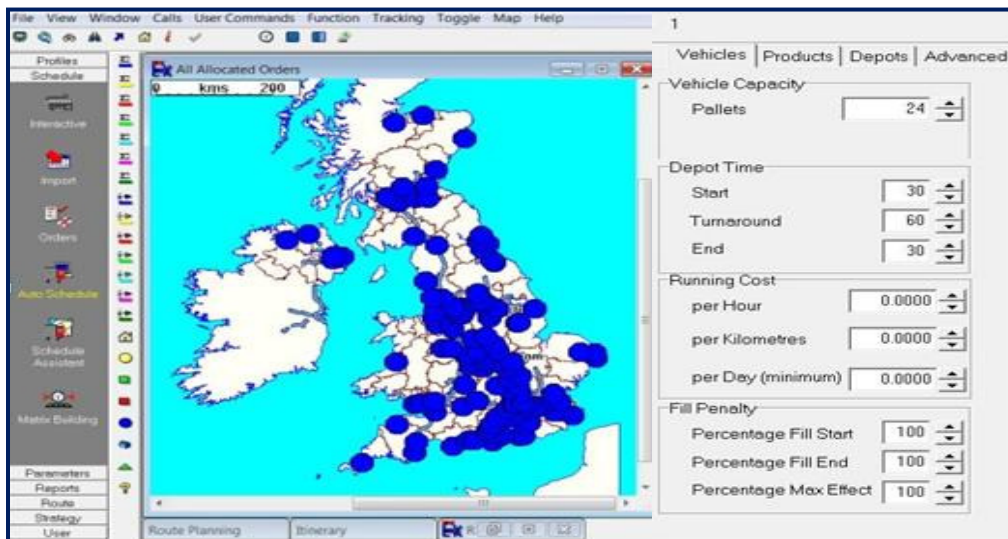
Hard Cheese!
